GUIDELINES FOR USE OF SOUTH SHORE YACHT CLUB FACILITIES**

Members of the Junior Program may use SSSYC at the hours established by the SSSYC Board of Directors as follows:

May 1 - September 15 (MONDAY-FRI) 9:00AM - 6:00PM

All other times: Only previously announced Junior Activities.

This rule does not limit the privileges of Juniors who are with their parents or other adult members.

General Rules for All Juniors:

1. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
2. Smoking is prohibited.
3. Physical rough housing, fighting and wrestling are prohibited.
4. Juniors are discouraged from congregating in the Lower Level Bar area. They should make their purchases (NON-ALCOHOLIC) and return to the Junior Clubhouse.

All SSSYC Junior Program members are expected to conduct themselves in a responsible manner at all times. Failure to do so may result in suspension or dismissal from the Junior Program.
