RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as modified by the Racing Rules of Sailing: Appendix E and the Dragon Force 65 restricted class rules.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The series is open to DragonForce 65 “stock” with the A rig sailboats only.
An eligible boat may enter by agreeing to attend the Facebook event, or by showing up on the day of the race.
All boats shall be individually identified with markings on their sails or unique sail numbers.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- The Sailing Instructions will be posted online on the SSYC website. If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

RACING AREA

- The racing areas will be from the South Shore Yacht Club docks, “horse shoe”, or the docks by the north, or south derricks. The racing area may be changed by the participants subject to prevailing weather conditions and waves.

MEASUREMENT

- Measurement is on the honor system
- All boats shall be raced straight out of the box. No upgraded rigs or sails are permitted.
- Boats with lithium battery packs are permitted.

SCORING

- The Low Point Scoring system will be used.
- The value of a DNS (Did Not Start) or DNF (Did Not Finish) shall be the number of boats checked-in.
- The value for a DNC (Did Not Compete) score shall be the number of boats checked-in plus one (1).
- Dropped races will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

- Series Awards: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd overall
