Sailing Instructions

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by Appendix E and the Dragon Force 65 Restricted Class Rules.

2 CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Any change to the sailing instructions can be made orally at the time of racing.
- 2.2 Any change made orally, which applies to the series shall be subsequently posted online 4as an amendment to these Sailing Instructions.

3 SCHEDULE

4 RACING AREA

The racing area will be announced on the day of the event.

5 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 5.1 Entry is free.
- 5.2 All boats must have sail #s, or a unique way of identifying their boat.
- 5.3 All boats will be DragonForce 65 stock. "Straight out of the box"
- 5.4 "A" rig sail kits only

6 COURSES/MARKS

The course diagram is shown in Appendix A

7 START/FINISH

7.1 Races will be started in accordance with rule E3.4, following a 2 minute starting sequence.

7.2 Start and finish line are the same.

7.3 Signals will be made orally.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

Penalties while racing: rule 44.1 is changed to a boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of either Part 2, or 31 in an incident while racing.

9 TIME LIMIT

The time limit for a race will be 20 minutes.

10 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

10.1 Protests will be delivered to the SSYC bar.

10.2 A boat's protest time limit is 5 minutes after the last boat finishes for the day.

11 SCORING

11.1 The series will be scored using the low point scoring system.

11.2 The value of DNS (did not start) and DNF (did not finish) shall be the number of boats checked in that race day.

11.3 The value of DNC (did not compete) will be the number of boats checked-in plus one (1).

11.4 Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst scores. The number of allowable scores to be excluded will be prorated based on the number of races completed as defined below:
