Distance Race 1 Saturday 7/7/2018 MYC Big Triangle

Distance Race 2 Friday 8/3/2018 Racine Race

Distance Race 3 Friday 8/31/2018 Port Washington Race

## **9.2 THE RACINE DISTANCE RACE COURSE**

The Racine Distance Race will be a 17.1 nm distance race. The start will be the Green Bell Buoy (S) mark to starboard and the RC signal vessel to Port, then to the R-14 Bell Buoy rounded to starboard, then to R-16 Nun rounded to starboard, then to the finish at Racine Reef West End Lighted Buoy 1 (having green flashing light with a period of 4 seconds and a range of 4 miles.) with the RC signal vessel to Port. See Illustration "B".

The Approximate LL for the Racine Yacht Club Race course throw-in finish buoy is:

**N 42.43.386**

**W 087.45.941**

## **10.2 DISTANCE RACE MARKS**

The Racine Distance Races are as follows:

The South (S) mark is the green government Bell Buoy.

The R-14 mark is a red government Bell Buoy.

The R-16 mark is a red government Nun Buoy.

The Finish mark will Racine Reef West End Lighted Buoy 1.

13.4 All boats finishing after dusk shall illuminate either her mainsail or sail number board on the rail while finishing

15.3 For the Racine Distance Race the time limit for all boats is 0:05.

15.4 For the Racine Distance Race, if the lead boat has not rounded the R-14 Bell Buoy by 22:30 hours, the race committee may abandon the race

15.5 If boats racing cannot, in the judgment of the race committee, place ahead of any boat finished, the race committee may record the time and the relative positions of the boats racing.

The boat(s) are not required to "Finish". The race committee will attempt to notify the boats involved by hail or by radio. This changes rule 35.
